We express our sincere gratitude for your involvement in the Young Ambassador Program. Enclosed herewith is essential guidance designed to assist participating embassies and organizations in establishing expectations and fostering meaningful engagement with your designated Young Ambassadors. This guidance aims to direct your activities throughout the program period, spanning from the official launch on December 13, 2023, until March 31, 2024.

Expectations

Each participating embassy/organization is requested to engage in a minimum of two interactions per month with the Young Ambassador, with the exception of December, during which one interaction is sufficient due to school holidays unless the organization desires more involvement.

One interaction per month should center on mentoring, while the other should provide exposure to diplomatic realities. This may involve including the Young Ambassador in meetings or events, such as sessions with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, government bodies, companies, business associations, etc.

We recommend that the initial interaction following the program launch serve as an introduction for the Young Ambassador to the Ambassador/Representative and the team. This meeting should include an overview of embassy/organizational activities, priorities in Kuwait, and commence the mentoring process.

Subsequent to the introductory meeting, the host organization and the Young Ambassador can collaboratively schedule monthly engagements based on each party's availability. Host embassies/ organizations, especially those with smaller teams, are encouraged to partner with other hosts for these events.

Program organizers will extend invitations to all Young Ambassadors for a joint learning/networking event each month, enhancing their advocacy skills. Host Embassies are encouraged to observe or participate, depending on the activity.



Draft Timeline

2023

December 2023

- Ambassadors/Organizational Representatives participate in the program launch on December 13th at UN House, introducing Young Ambassadors to their "host" Embassy.
- Host organizations arrange an introductory meeting with their Young Ambassador before the end of December (minimum one meeting);
- Young Ambassadors are invited to participate in activities related to climate action.

Launch Event at the UN House:

- Ice breaker session led by Dima Al-Ansari (TBC)
- Introductory meeting for candidates with host embassy/organization

February 2024

- Host organizations arrange at least two interactions with Young Ambassador – one mentoring session and one meeting to provide exposure to diplomatic practice.
- Young Ambassadors participate in additional learning/networking events in February (TBC).

 - Field trip to Jahra Natural Reserve led by EPA
 - Public Bus Tour with Kuwait Commute

January 2024

- Host organizations arrange at least two interactions with the Young Ambassador – one mentoring session and one meeting to provide exposure to diplomatic practice.
- Young Ambassadors participate in the first of three communications/improv workshops with Dima Al-Ansari from Staged in Kuwait to assist them in developing advocacy and negotiation skills.

March 2024

2024

- Final meeting between host organization and Young Ambassador.
 - Improv session 3
 - Visit to Enviroserve plant or STEAM session led by
 - Wrap-up event on or around March 31, 2024.
