INNOVATE FOR GOOD PROGRAM

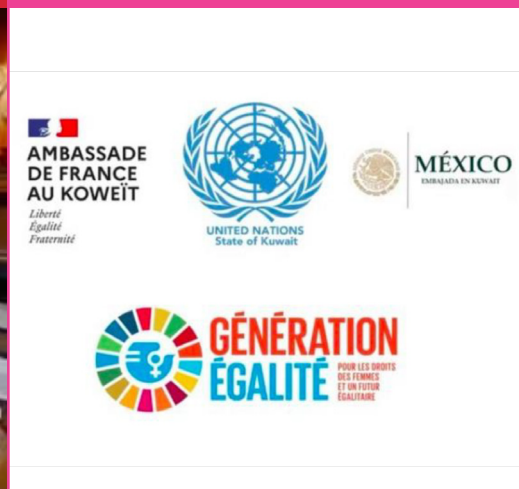

INTERNATIONAL DAY OF WOMEN AND GIRLS IN SCIENCE

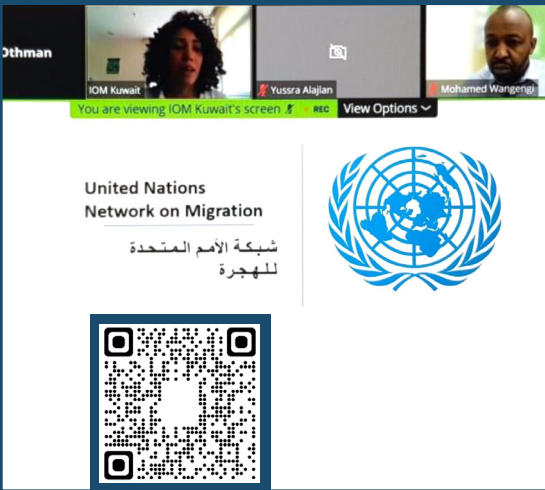

WHO COUNTRY OFFICE ESTABLISHMENT

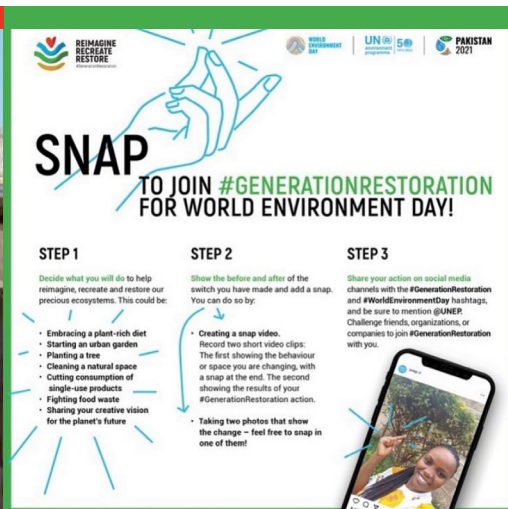

AGREEMENT GRANT WITH UNRWA AND KUWAIT FUND

A signing of a grant agreement between the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) and the Kuwait Development Fund, under which the Fund provides a grant of \$500,000 to contribute to the funding of the UNRWA health programme in the Lebanese Republic, which aims to ensure the continuation of health-care services for Palestine refugees in the Lebanese Republic, by contributing to the support of the UNRWA health programme for Palestine refugees in the Lebanese Republic through the provision of health-care services and hospitalization expenses for some 2,936 patients in need of medical care include treatment of cancer, cardiovascular diseases, intensive care, burns and other specialized services.

The parties also signed another \$20 million grant agreement to support the Agency's general programme budget for 2021 and 2022, which will help the Agency continue to provide vital humanitarian services to Palestine refugees in Lebanon, Syria, Jordan, Gaza and the West Bank, which include East Jerusalem.

The grant agreements were signed on behalf of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) by the Under-Secretary-General of the United Nations and Commissioner-General of the Agency, Mr. Philippe Lazarini, while on behalf of the Kuwait Development Fund, the Director-General, Mr. Marwan Abdallah Thallah Thanyan Ghanim. This contribution falls within the framework of the commitment made by the State of Kuwait during the Third Ministerial Strategic Dialogue on the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), held on 15 October 2020, in support of its objectives of ensuring and protecting Palestinian refugees and ensuring the delivery of assistance and basic services to them.

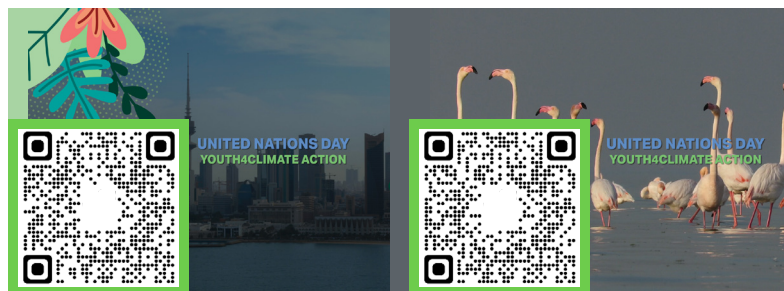
UNITED NATIONS DAY

The United Nations in Kuwait celebrated the United Nations Day by organizing an exhibition to highlight the efforts of youth towards climate action in Kuwait, the exhibition was based around the Sustainable Development Goal 13 on Climate Action and was held at the UN House, many youth activists were invited to showcase their initiatives and how they contributed to a greener Kuwait. The exhibition titled "Youth4Climate Action" was held on October 23rd and 24th. On the sidelines of the exhibition, photographs depicting beautiful landscapes and wildlife were displayed on external screens of prominent buildings.

The Youth4Climate Action Exhibition was sponsored by Kuwait's Foreign Minister and State Minister for Cabinet Affairs Sheikh Dr Ahmad Nasser Al-Mohammad Al-Sabah. The Foreign Minister gave a speech in which he expressed pride at having participated in such an event, as the UN serves as a reference for Kuwait's diplomatic work by promoting tolerance, peace, and striving towards a better world. In his speech, the minister thanked Dr. Tarek El-Sheikh, The United Nations Secretary-General Representative and The RC, and all those who work in the UN House in Kuwait for their considerable organization efforts and continuous hard work in representing Kuwait's strategic relations with the UN. Dr. Ahmad also spoke of Kuwait's long-standing history with the UN beginning in Kuwait joining the organization in 1963, and cited Kuwait's ongoing efforts in limiting human suffering. He also noted the UN's role in helping Kuwait regain its independence in 1991, and stated that it is a prime example of the organization's work in keeping peace and maintaining security. The minister stated that this comes as a continuation of the late Amir of Kuwait Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah's humanitarian efforts, which will doubtlessly be continued by His Highness the Amir of Kuwait Sheikh Nawaf Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah and His Highness the Crown Prince Sheikh Mishal Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah. He also mentioned the toll the coronavirus pandemic took on all aspects of life, and highlighted how it required the international community

to join efforts and collaborate to face such challenges and eradicate the pandemic. The Foreign Minister took a tour around the Exhibition and had the chance to meet with the participating initiatives. Some of the initiatives included organic gardening, healthy cities, recycling, and food sustainability. The participants showcased their work to visitors and some distributed samples of what they provide. During the Exhibition, speakers from various fields were invited to present and speak on topics of interest to the youth. One of which was a local initiative that encourages people to use public transportation, another was a dairy farmer that spoke of the effects of climate change on their land and cattle, another speaker presented the importance of native species to the land in Kuwait and previewed field studies of natural habitat in Kuwait. In celebration of United Nations Day, A documentary was also developed to showcase the biodiversity of Kuwait. The documentary was previewed in Kuwait National Television. The documentary included interviews of local sustainable farmers and initiatives, United Nations representatives, and local entrepreneurs.

The United Nations day 2021 was celebrated by different organizations and individuals from various parts of Kuwait and different fields. The cooperation between initiatives and locals was highlighted and the youth were given the opportunity to experience and learn more about way of playing a role in climate action.

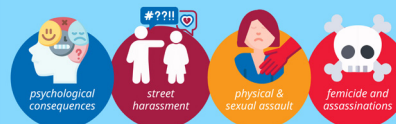

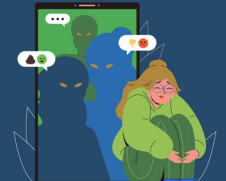

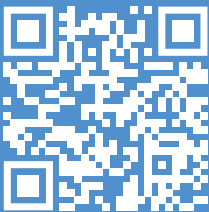
