Mr. Muhammad Jassim Al-Saqer - Chairman of the Kuwait Chamber of Commerce and Industry met with Mrs. Rabaa Hussein Makki Al-Jumuah, Senior Adviser to the Office of the UNRC in Kuwait and Director of the Kuwait and Qatar Office of the United Nations Global Compact, on Sunday, October 30, 2022. The meeting was attended by Mr. Rabah Abdul Rahman Al-Rabah - General Manager of the Chamber.

This meeting came within the framework of the Chamber's approval of joining the United Nations Global Compact, which is the largest initiative for the principle of sustainability in the world in achieving its 17 goals, as its membership includes 17,000 companies, 4,000 non-profit institutions in more than 177 countries and more than 70 local networks. It aims to invite responsible companies and institutions to work on aligning their strategies and operations with the most prominent global challenges, which are represented by ten global principles in four basic areas: human rights, labor, environment, and combating corruption.

Where Mr. Al-Sager affirmed the Chamber's support for the ten principles of the Charter and work to take a responsible and integrated approach to achieve these declared goals It is noteworthy that the United Nations Global Compact is committed to providing everything that can be a pioneering catalyst and support for this transformation, which will be adopted by the responsible companies and institutions if they join the agreement. The agreement will also provide the participants with a comprehensive set of tools, including platforms for providing solutions, and the United Nations Business Center through the Internet and all the resources that will help the participants to take all necessary actions to achieve sustainable development.





ISLAMIC PHILANTHROPY MID YEAR REPORT 2022

UNHCR, the UN Refugee Agency launched its Islamic Philanthropy Mid Year Report 2022 which highlights the humanitarian impact of Zakat and Sadaqah donations received through UNHCR's Refugee Zakat Fund during the first six months of 2022.

The report was released during an event held at the United Nations House "Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah Building" in Kuwait, in coordination with the Kuwaiti Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and in partnership with Zakat House in Kuwait.

The event included a presentation of the report's outcomes, in addition to panel discussions about the role of Zakat and Sadaqah in responding to humanitarian crises, and the relief impact of Kuwaiti organizations through utilizing Islamic

philanthropy tools. The event was attended by representatives of governmental entities, diplomats, and a number of UNHCR's international philanthropy partners in Kuwait, UAE, KSA, Indonesia and Turkiye, in addition to representatives from the private sector.



DEVELOPMENT REFORM SUPPORT AGREEMENT FOR ROHINGYA REFUGEES AGENDA The Office of the United Nations: High Commissioner for Defugees in the State of Kuwa

Dr. Tarek ElSheikh United Nations Secretary-General Representative to Kuwait had the pleasure to meet Kuwait Permanent Representative to the United Nations Tarek AlBanai @mofakuwait . And had very fruitful exchange on development reform Agenda as Kuwait being the current Chair of the UN Reform Committee. The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees in the State of Kuwait and the International Charitable Association for Development and Development "Tanmia Charity" signed a grant agreement to provide health support in terms of medicine and clean water supplies for drinking to Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh at the headquarters of Tanmia Charity.

This agreement comes within the framework of the joint fundraising campaign launched by UNHCR, in partnership with Tanmia, in the month of Ramadan 2022 to support the Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh, as it is expected that more than 153,000 people will benefit from it. The charity contribution will help provide safe water supplies and the zakat money will help in providing essential medicines, for example, antibiotics, pain relief medicine, medicine for inflammatory diseases, etc., to the Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh.

More than 5 years after more than 700,000 Rohingya fled Myanmar, joining hundreds of thousands of Rohingya who had sought refuge in Bangladesh years earlier, UNHCR is calling on the international community to do more to secure financial support and solutions for more than 943,000 refugees from Myanmar. The Rohingya, who remain fully dependent on humanitarian assistance for their survival, face many challenges to meet basic needs such as shelter, proper nutrition, hygiene facilities and livelihood opportunities.





YOUNG AMBASSADORS INITIATIVE

"When we guarantee the rights of people with disabilities, we bring our world closer to upholding the core values and principles of the United Nations Charter.

180 member states have ratified the Convention on Persons with Disabilities. 15% of the world's population or one billion people are persons with disabilities. 80% of people with disabilities live in developing countries. Seven of the Sustainable Development Goals refer to persons with disabilities.

The United Nations, through the United Nations Development Program, has cooperated with the General Secretariat of the Supreme Council for Planning and Development and the General Authority for Persons with Disabilities in a technical cooperation program to support the state's efforts to support and develop plans, programs and priorities for people with disabilities.

The United Nations Disability Inclusion Strategy provides the foundation for sustainable and transformative progress in disability inclusion through all pillars of the United Nations' work: peace and security, human rights and development.

The strategy enables the UN system to support the implementation of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities and other international human rights instruments, as well as the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals, the Humanitarian Agenda and the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction

Persons with Disabilities The campaign of Partners to Employ Them in its various versions was adopted by:

- Dual Track Approach

Integration of disability-sensitive measures in the design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of all policies and programs and undertaking initiatives specifically related to disability to support the empowerment of persons with disabilities at work. The campaign has worked on this through training, dialogue meetings and employment forums.

- Versatility

Factors such as gender, age, and location shape an individual's experience. These factors also affect people with disabilities and their experiences in life. The campaign (Partners in Employing Them) was comprehensive and integrated for young men and women of different age groups with multiple skill levels and also different backgrounds leading to clear diversity. The diversity of employers for people with disabilities and the multiplicity of job aspects and capabilities played a major role. in the success of the campaign.

- Coordination

A coherent and coordinated approach is essential in order to accelerate progress, build on each other's work, and achieve integration. This is considered one of the most important elements of success. In this regard, we commend the role of the Human Development Institute and the Public Authority for Persons with Disabilities.




