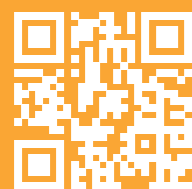




SAFE CITIES INDEX 2021

The Economist Intelligence Unit, sponsored by NEC, has released the Safe Cities Index 2021, covering 60 major urban areas. In its fourth edition, the Index consists of 76 sub indicators grouped under 5 domains.

Five Domains of the Safe Cities Index & Top cities:



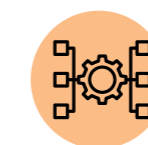
Digital Security

Leading in digital security are: Sydney, Singapore, Copenhagen, Los Angeles and San Francisco



Health Security

Leading in Health security are: Tokyo, Singapore, Hong Kong, Melbourne and Osaka



Infrastructure Security

Leading in Infrastructure security are: Hong Kong, Singapore, Copenhagen, Toronto, Tokyo



Personal Security

Leading in Personal security are: Copenhagen, Amsterdam, Frankfurt, Stockholm, Brussels



Environmental Security

Leading in Environmental security are: Wellington, Toronto, Washington, DC, Bogota and Milan

KUWAIT CITY

According to the 2021 index results, Kuwait ranked fourth in the Arab world as the safest city after Abu Dhabi, Dubai and Riyadh, while ranking 53rd globally in the index, and scoring 49.4 points out of 100.

Kuwait ranked 27th in Health Security with an above the average score of 69.7.

Kuwait scored below the average in the other four domains. With regards to Personal Security domain, **Kuwait ranked 37th in the world**, scoring 58 points.

In Infrastructure Security, **Kuwait's rank was 51** (score: 53.4).

Kuwait's rank in Digital Security was 54 with a score of 43.6.

In Environmental Security, Kuwait was at the bottom of the list, ranking 60th with a 22.0 score.

The index ranked Copenhagen as the safest city, followed by Toronto, Singapore, Sydney and Tokyo.
